


Caribbean Itinerary



Day 1 - St. Martin

- Meet and greet at the airport and Transfer to the Yacht in Isle de Sol Marina
- Welcome cocktails and meet the crew, followed by Captain's briefing and safety presentation.
- Depart Simpson Bay for the short trip to Grand Case Bay on the French side. Although well developed this is a nice place for a swim and walk ashore.
- Afternoon of playing in the water with the toys.









Day 2 - Anguilla

- Early morning departure for a short trip to Anguilla. Arrive in time for breakfast and new view!
- Anchor off uninhabited Dog Island, which is part of the fringing reefs to the NW of Anguilla and within the Anguillan Marine Park system.
- Spend the day exploring the island by foot, or try the kayaks. Snorkelling here is excellent.
- Evening beach BBQ
- Overnight or early morning cruise to St. Kitts









Day 3 - St. Kitts

- St. Kitts offers a good opportunity to for some land based activities, including Ziplining, Golf or visits to Brimstone Hill National Park, Romney Manor, Caribelle Batiki and The Art Studios of Kate Design.
- Afternoon anchored off and swimming, scuba diving or playing with the water toys.
- Sundowners followed by donner on board. Maybe arrange for a local band to play on board for the evening?









Day 4 - Nevis

- Breakfast and a swim when at anchor in St Kitts, before a 40 minute sail across to neighbouring Nevis.
- Relax on board before heading ashore to the Montpelier Plantation www.montpeliernevis.com
- End the afternoon by relaxing, swimming and playing with the water toys.
- Dinner at the unique Mill Privee restaurant within the Plantation.










Day 5 - Antigua

- Early morning departure for Antigua. Anchor off in time for breakfast before heading in to port to explore the historic Nelson's Dock.
- Afternoon short 40 minute sail to Green Bay on the SE of the island to anchor off Green Island.
- Lunch at Harmony Hall, with its stunning views over Green Bay and historic sugar mill.
- End the afternoon by exploring the uninhabited Green Island, trying some windsurfing or simply relaxing on board.
- Re-locate to port or anchor off for a sundowners and dinner on board.
- Reposition overnight to St. Barths.










Day 6 - St. Barths

- Breakfast at anchor in the Marine Park of Colombier Bay, which can only be reached by boat of by foot. There is a beautiful sandy beach that offers excellent snorkelling. Colombier is also known as Rockefeller's Beach as David Rockefeller owned the land that surrounded it for many years.
- Lunch on board before repositioning just outside the port and main town of Gustavia.
- Take the tender into the port for some exploring, sightseeing and shopping.
- Dinner ashore.









Day 7 - St. Martin

- Early morning departure for Long Bay Beach, near Marigot on the French side of St Martin.
- Either a leisurely breakfast, swim or long walk on the beach, before heading back for the short sail to Simpson Bay and Isle de Sol Marina for guest departure.
- Transfer to airport. Transfer can be done by tender.













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
